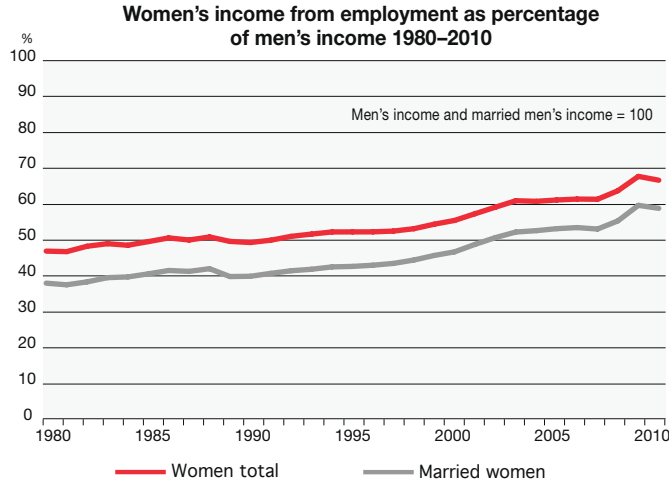

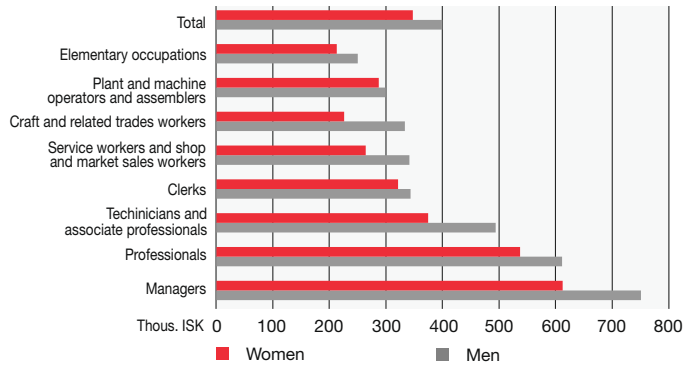
Positions of influence

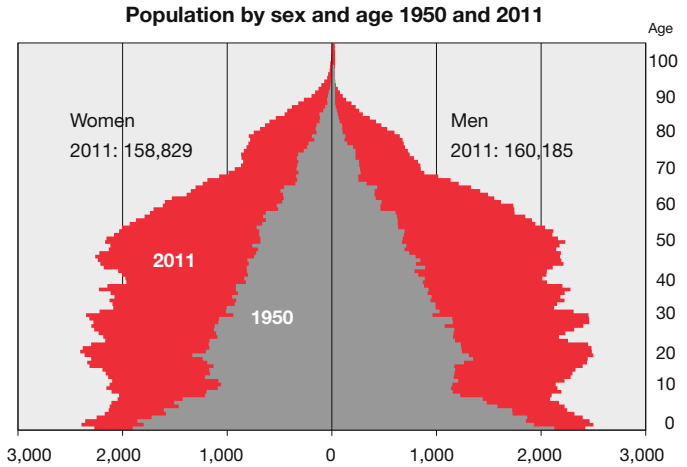


Regular monthly salaries of FT employees in the private sector 2010

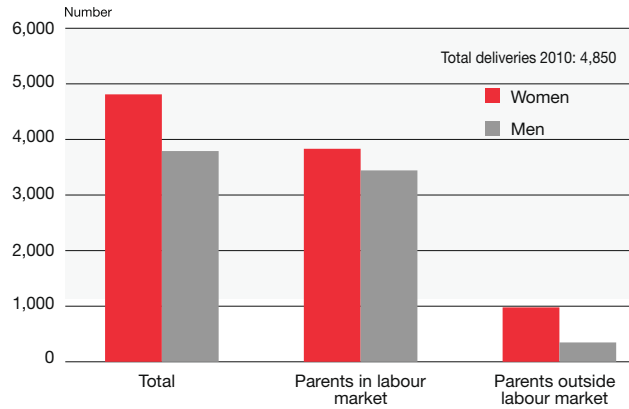

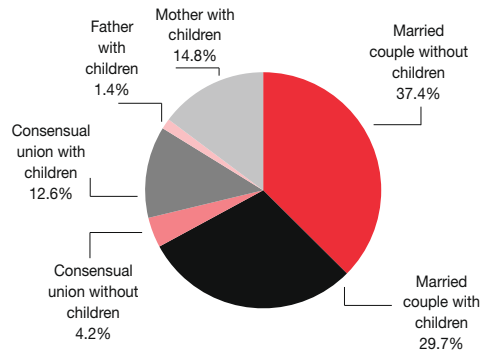

Parents in paid maternity/paternity leave by birthyear of child 2010

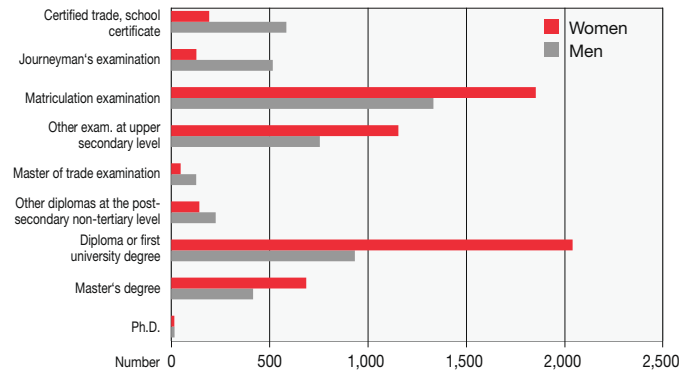

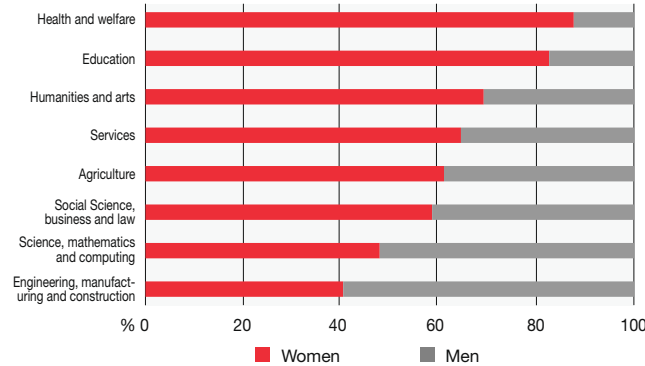

Graduations by diploma 2009/2010

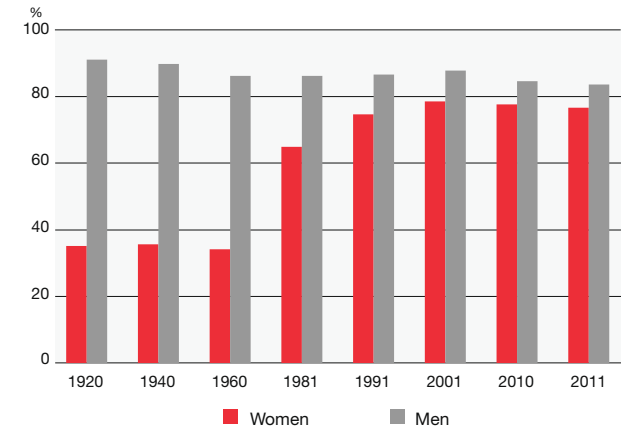


Graduations at tertiary level 2009/2010

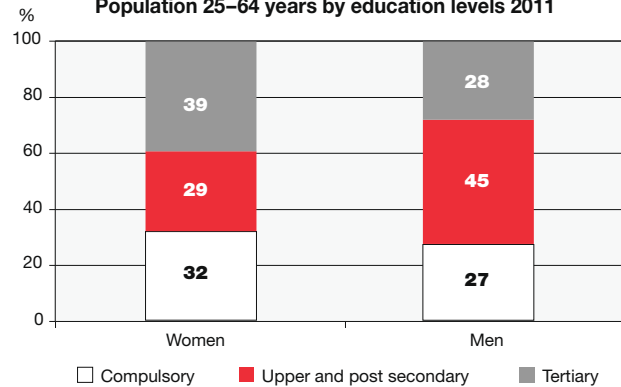
