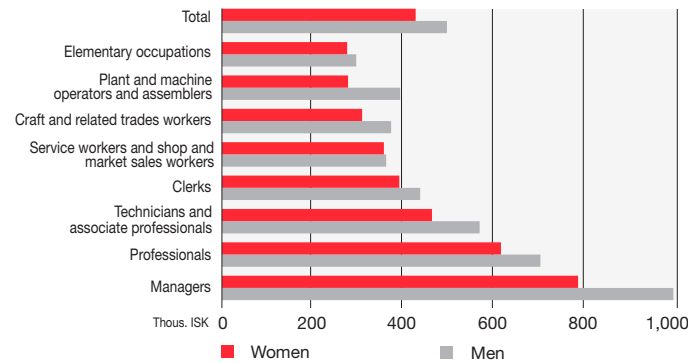
### Positions of influence

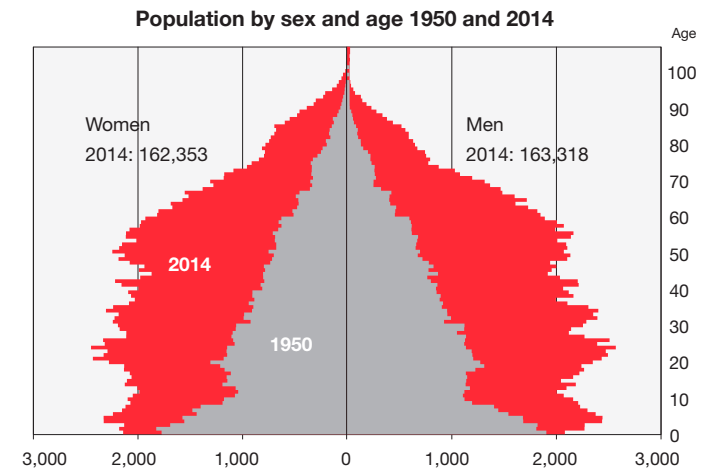


### Regular monthly salaries of FT employees in the private sector 2013

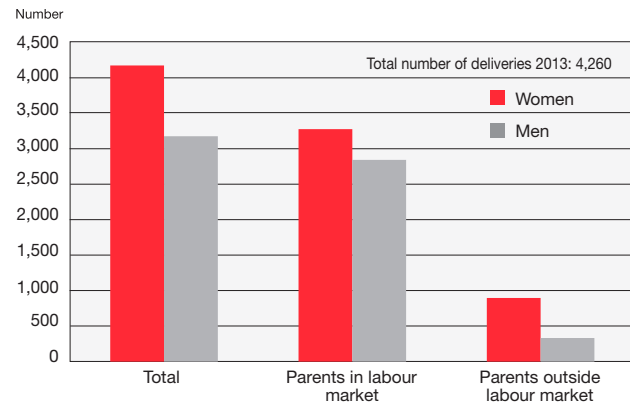

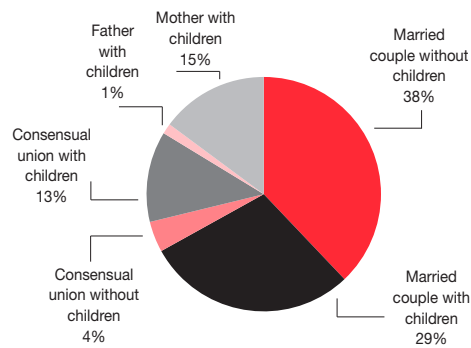

#### Women aged 18–80 who have experienced violence by men

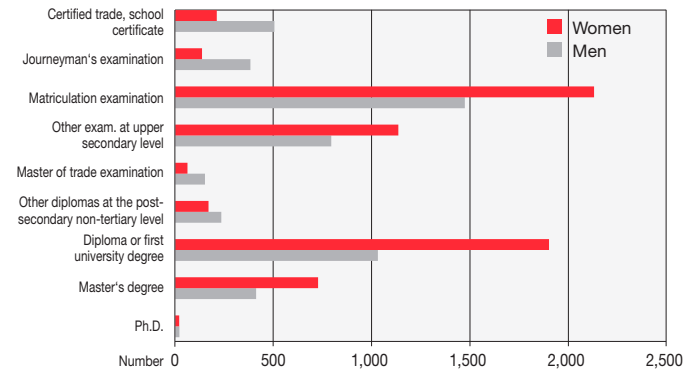

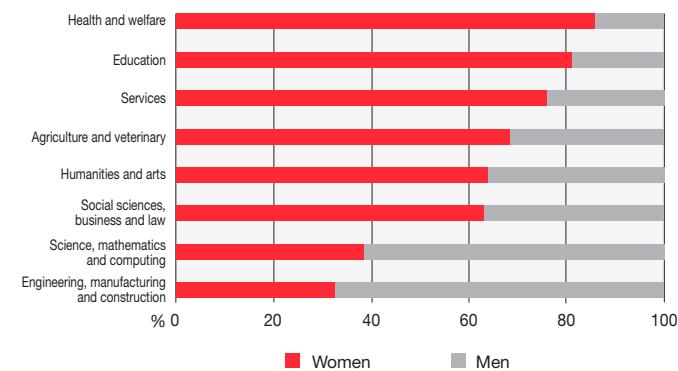

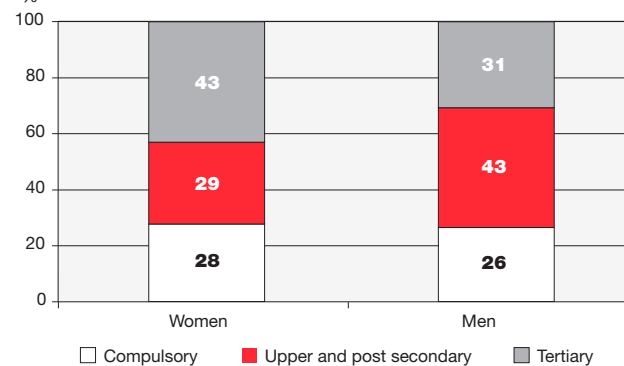
#### Graduations by diploma 2011/2012



#### Graduations at tertiary level 2011/2012

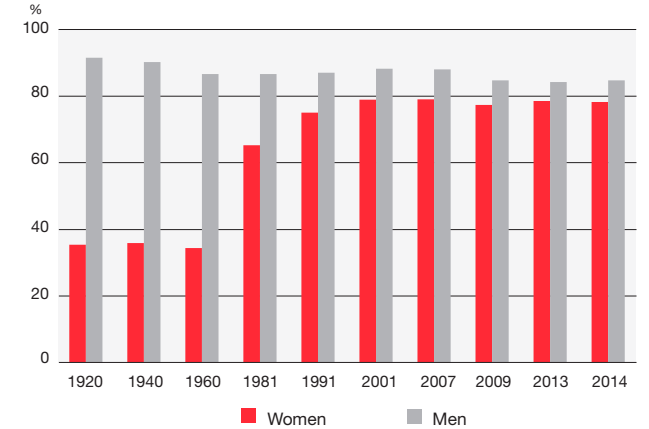


#### Population 25–64 years by education levels 2014
