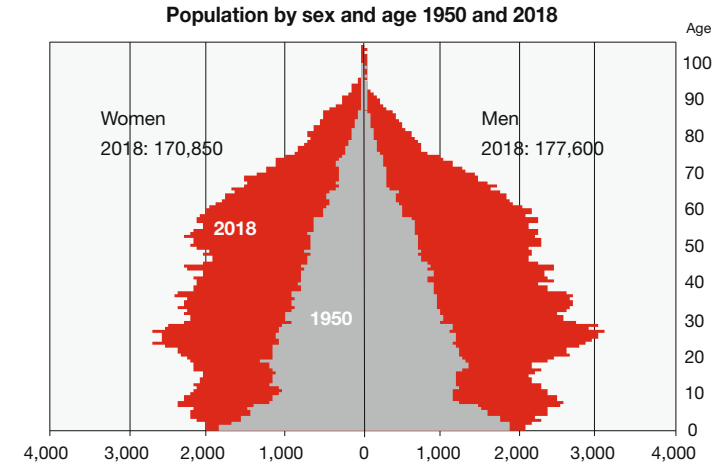

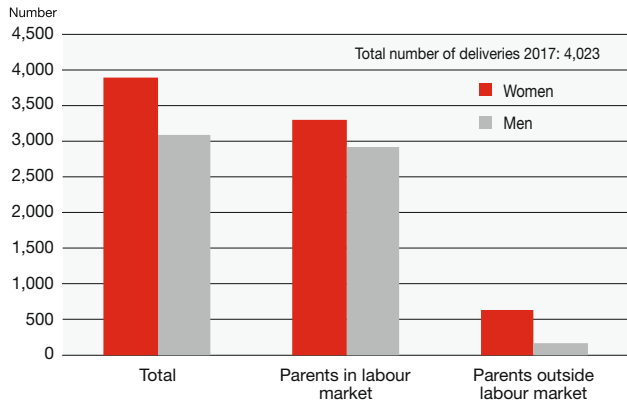

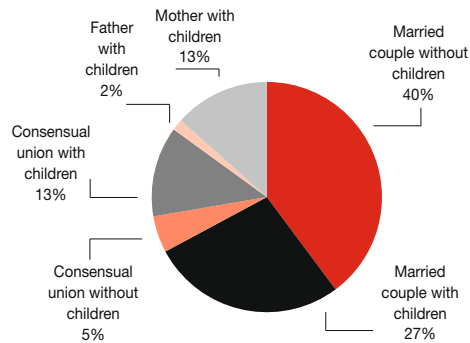

### Parents in paid maternity/paternity leave by birthyear of child 2017

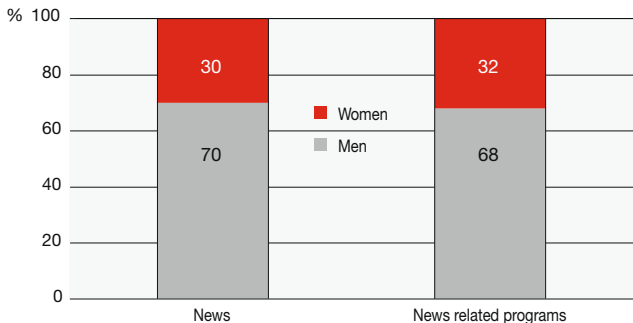

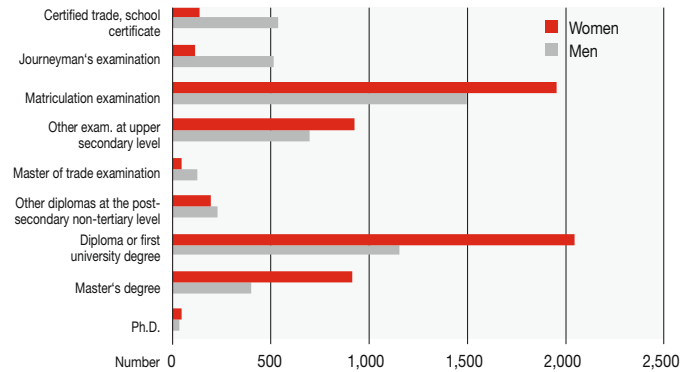
#### Interviewees in news and news related programs by gender 2014–2015



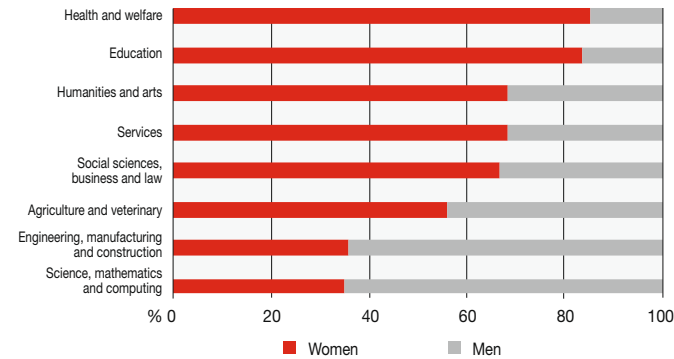

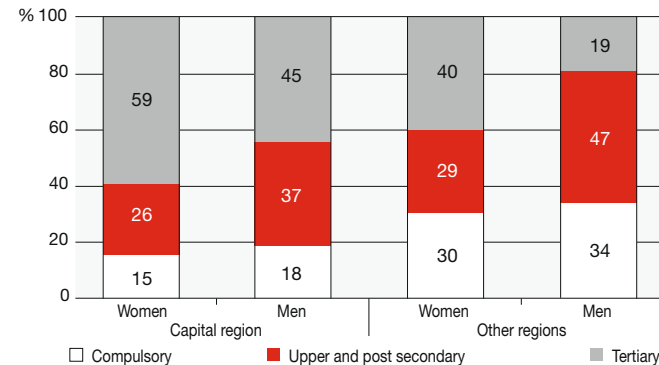
#### Graduations by diploma 2015/2016



#### Graduations at tertiary level 2015/2016

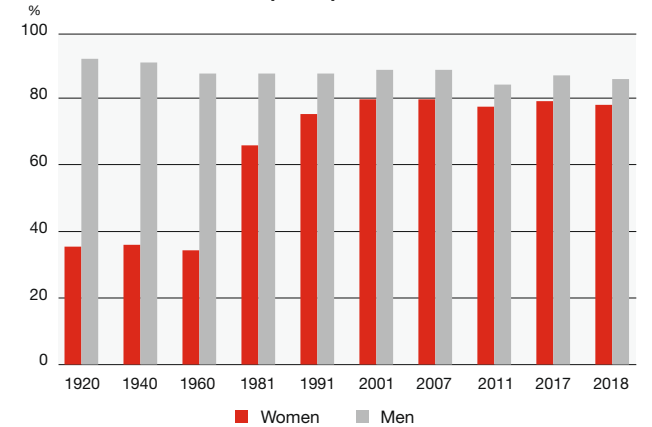


#### Population 25–64 years by educational attainment and region 2018
